

Nursing & Midwifery Uniforms

While you are on clinical placement, please wear the designated uniform for nursing and midwifery students from The University of the Sunshine Coast.

The uniform includes:

- Uniform top (Teal scrub style top) with USC logo (can ONLY be purchased from the following website: <http://www.infectious.com.au/usc-nurses>)
- Black trousers (not scrub trousers or jeans)
- Black shoes (leather closed-in with non-slip soles)
- Student identification
- Name badge with your first name only in a clear font that can be easily read. They can be purchased from any shoe repair store, trophy store, or for example, from [Medically Sound](#).

Please note: Uniforms can take up to 4 weeks to arrive.

If for some reason you are unable to wear the uniform, please discuss this with your Course Coordinator. Please present to placement with a professional appearance (no cleavage or midriff showing). Tie long hair up and ensure fingernails are short, clean and free of nail polish to adhere to health and safety requirements. A pair of earrings (studs) is the only permitted jewellery. Queensland Health have a 'bare below the elbow' policy meaning no clothing or jewellery is to be worn below the elbow.
